As to our Committee taking more of your constitutional argument, I am not authorized to say and must postpone a definite answer until I shall have ascertained.

The only difficulty I apprehend, will be scarcity of funds. We mean to keep the work on [?]hand[?], & it is constantly advertised in our paper, of which we issue 10,000 copies monthly, & are in process [sic] of sending to all the lawyers in the free states. When in Boston W. [?]Tassau[?] and myself took of W. Marsh 34 copies, of which 17 are on hand, & we have given away, here ____ as many as we have sold.
